The time and date of this demonstration will be communicated to bidders separately. Only if the bidder conducts a successful and satisfactory live demonstration, will their bid be considered for financial bid opening.

Preference shall be given to the bidders belong to the Scheduled caste but they should fulfill all the technical and financial criteria.
